

SPARAXIS
(Harlequin Flower)

Beautiful splashes of color come from the tiniest corm. Flowers are 2" across on slender stems of 8"-12". Sparaxis looks best when planted in groups.

LOCATION:

Sunny area.

PLANT:

Corms should be planted 2" deep and 2" apart in well-drained soil. Incorporate peat moss and compost into the soil.

FLOWERING TIME:

July and August.

AFTER CARE:

Dig up corms in later summer and store in vermiculite in a cool place (40-50 degrees).
