

ISMENE (HYMENOCALLIS)
(Peruvian Daffodil)

Ismene has an elegant white, fragrant spider-like flower and grows on an 18” tall, strong stem.

LOCATION:

Sunny or filtered sun where summers are hot.

PLANT:

Just below the soil surface after all danger of frost is past. Peruvian daffodils do very well in pots also.

FLOWERING TIME:

Mid-summer into early fall.

AFTER CARE:

When leaves start to yellow in the fall, withhold water until the leaves are brown. Dig up the bulbs and allow to dry and store in vermiculite in a cool, dry place for winter.
