

TILLANDSIAS – TROPICAL AIR PLANTS

These unique plants are found naturally in Central and South America.

Tillandsia grow without soil and are found clinging to rock and trees, but they are not parasites.

ALL TILLANDSIAS BLOOM! They have a bright long lasting flowers, some plants will change colors completely and the blooming process may last 2 to 6 months. After the plants bloom they produce off shoots called pups. Pups are completely independent plants and can be removed for the parent plant when the pup reaches half the size of the parent plant.

CARE: Tillandsias store moisture, air, and nutrients thru the gray fuzzy cells on the plants. Simply mist your plant daily depending on the location. Do not allow water to accumulate in base of plant. Give your plant plenty of light and air.
